GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY.

I the undersigned Mirjam Stern do hereby appoint Dr. Joseph Stern of Jerusalem, Palestine, and/or David Hes of Haifa, Palestine, jointly and severally to be my lawful attornies in Palestine for all and singular the following purposes, that is to say:-



1. To appear on my behalf before all Courts of Palestine in connection with any matter pending between me and any other person or persons.
2. To institute, prosecute, enforce, abandon, defend, oppose, intervene as third party in, counterclaim, set-off, settle, adjust, compromise or refer to arbitration, any action, suit, appeal, demand, dispute, account, and matter whatsoever relating to the premises as between me and any other person or persons.
3. To issue notarial or other notices and protests and to apply for and obtain attachments and seizures whether provisional or executory, and to tender the oath.
4. To execute all and any orders and judgments obtained in any of the suits as above mentioned, and to ask, sue for recover and receive all or any moneys, goods, effects, things, and property whether movable or immovable, payable or owing or belonging to me by virtue of these presents or in relation to the premises, and to receive, give and execute valid discharges therefor.
5. To sign, execute and do all such documents, instruments and things as may be necessary or expedient for giving effect to all or any of the matters aforesaid.
6. To represent me before any Executive, Administrative or Judicial Authority in Palestine and any Settlement Officer, Notary Public, Execution Office or Land Registry, in connection with any of the matters aforesaid.
7. To appear on my behalf before any Land Registry in Palestine and to obtain registration in my favour of any property real or personal and of any mortgage or mortgages, and to discharge any such mortgage or mortgages and receive consideration therefor.
8. To do all or any of the above acts or things either alone or in conjunction with anybody else, and to delegate all or any of the powers hereinbefore conferred to any substitute or substitutes.
